Notice of Annual General Meeting of Members

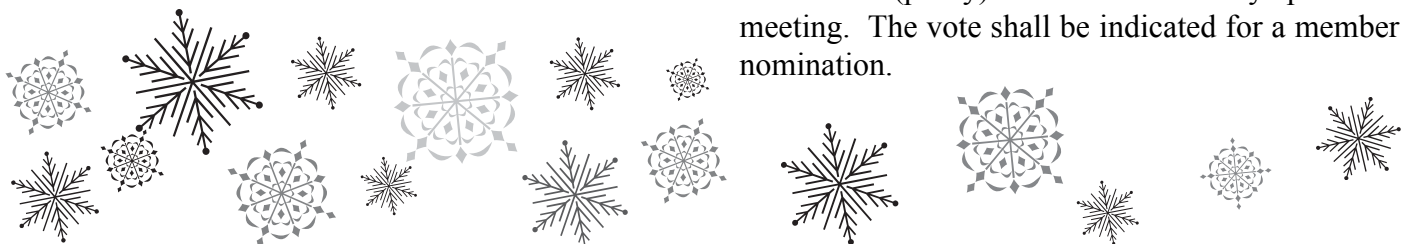
CSIA Atlantic Region

Election of Directors

In accordance with the CSIA Atlantic by-laws, all Provincial Representative positions will be up for election for a two-year term at this 2003 AGM.
